HOW DO I FIND A RIDE?

ON THE MAIN PAGE, ENTER IN YOUR:

- Trip origin
- Accessibility needs
- If you are scheduling a medical trip

THEN, YOU CAN CUSTOMIZE YOUR SEARCH TO INCLUDE

- Travel date
- Destination city or town
- Your preferred vehicle
- Your age; some services are only for seniors
- Your level of mobility
- Veteran status; some services are targeted towards Vets
- And Medicaid eligibility (for those who qualify for medical transit)

THE PROVIDERS SHOWN WILL HAVE INFORMATION PAGES ABOUT:

- Whether the service relies on you “Calling Ahead” or “Showing Up” to ride on the vehicle
- Days and times of operation
- Pricing/free status
- Contact numbers
- Website information
- Mobility Device Accommodation
